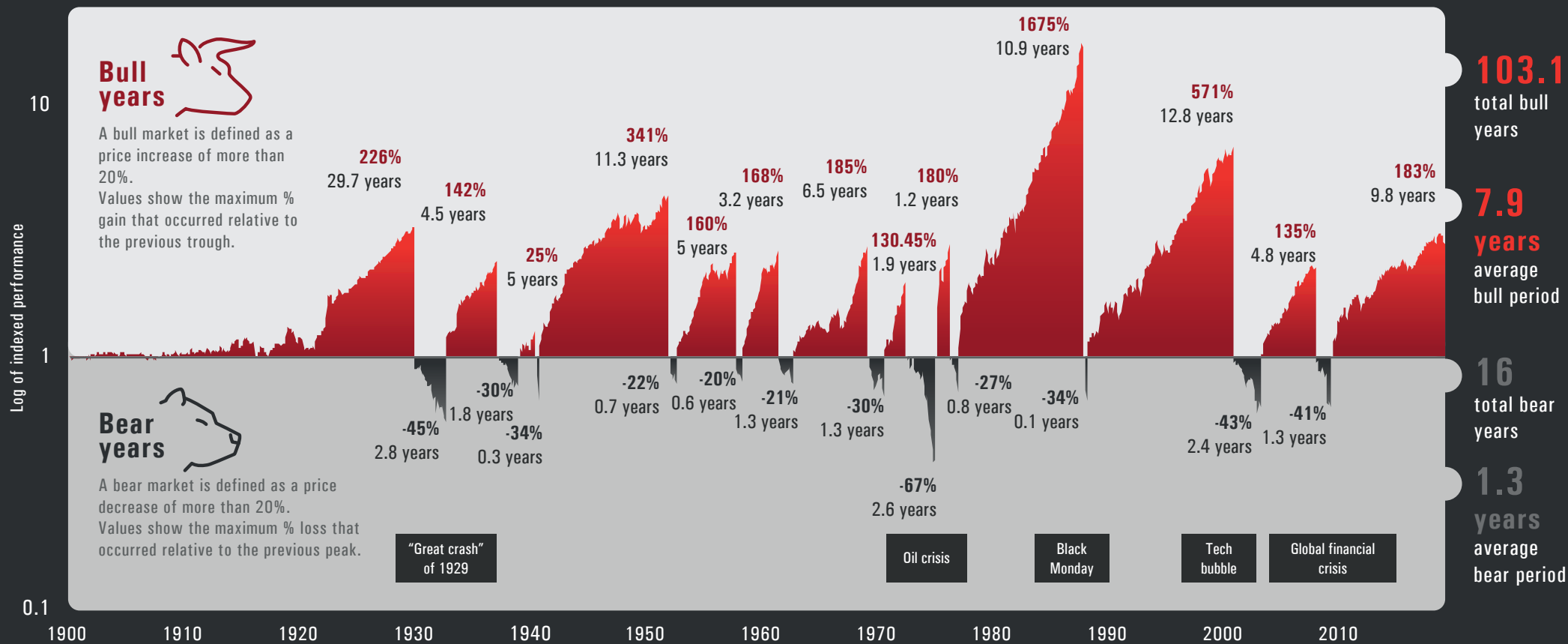


Bull and Bear Markets
